
New album from Kilkenny Band



The success of Kilkenny-based band Reverie has catapulted the duo into the national limelight. Together for just over two years, Russ Ryan and Myra Walsh will join Hot House Flowers, Mundy Rodriguez y Gabrialla, Mark Geary, Declan O'Rourke and Gerry Fish on the bill of this year *Woodstock Festival in Kilkenny*.

Though this is the first major concert for the pair, Reverie have been gigging around the country for some time. They have also performed on the club circuit in the UK. In 2002 Reverie had two of their songs short-listed for the Hot Press 'Song of the Year' national competition.



Adding an extra dimension to the band's sound is new member Paul Derby, on piano and guitar, Reverie will also attract much attention for their debut album "Faded Windows", released in July. This acoustic rock/folk album introduces some fine new song writing talent which is sure to garner much acclaim.

Writing credits on the album are shared between Russ and Myra, who blend their individual styles perfectly to produce a fascinating musical journey that is both moody and inspiring. Myra and Russ contribute vocals, also adding backing voices to each other's songs, and playing guitars.

Guest musicians include Stephen Dwane (drums and guitars), Michael Clarke (bass), Derek Darcy (harmonica and flute) and David Dwane (keyboards). "Faded Windows" was recorded at DwanSound Recording Studio in Ballina, Co. Mayo over a two year period, and mastered by Open Ear Productions, Galway. It was produced and engineered by David Dwane.
